Action Items:

- The Subcommittee will report to Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission regarding the information presented on commercial haul seining by the Department, Billy Rice, Bill Kilinski, and Capt. George Martin.
- The Subcommittee will amend language presented by Weimar regarding minority reports; Roger Trageser will begin an email thread to the subcommittee to formalize these changes; additional language could include the use of DNR staff to present future minority reports, when needed.
- The Department will invite specialists on aquatic habitat quality in the Bay to provide information or water quality data for the Subcommittee.
