# **Tri-Annual Fisheries Service Regulatory Scoping Public Meeting**

The Maryland Department of Natural Resources Fisheries Service will hold a Regulatory Scoping Public Meeting on February 23, 2011 at 6:00pm in the C-1 Conference Room of the Tawes State Office Building, 580 Taylor Avenue, Annapolis, MD 21401. All interested parties are invited to attend and give their views. Sign language interpreters and other appropriate accommodations will be provided upon request.

Tri-Annual Public Fisheries Regulatory Scoping Meetings are held to discuss possible changes to fishing rules. The public has the opportunity to comment at these meetings prior to the ideas becoming proposed regulations. Draft regulatory ideas are posted on the Fisheries' Service website and comments are taken by email, fax, or mail by a specified date and at the Public Scoping Meeting.

## **Regulatory Ideas**

## Standardization of Bushel Containers and Oyster Tagging

Brings Maryland in line with FDA requirements under the National Shellfish Sanitation Program's shellstock identification and traceability requirements.

### • TFL Buyback Program Permit Clarification

Clarifies the ability of individuals participating in the 2011 buyback program to transfer their permits.

#### Summer Flounder Recreational

Three options for 2011 season: 1) 18.5" size limit, 3 creel, and season Apr. 17- Nov. 22; 2) 18.5" size limit, 3 creel, and season Apr. 17- Nov. 22.

#### Penalties

Create a penalty for failing a striped bass or yellow perch tag audit.

### • Crabs

Modifications to regulation based on enforcement concerns.
