### **Motions & Actions**

#### Election of Chairman

Motion by Commissioner Lynch, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Coburn to appoint Jim Gracie as Chairman for a two-year term which extends through June of 2013. Vote: 11 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions. Motion passes.

Motion by Commissioner Lynch, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Goldsborough to appoint Bill Windley as Vice Chairman for a two-year term which extends through June of 2013. Vote: 11 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstention. Motion passes.

Motion by Commissioner Lynch to maintain the current rate schedule at MD toll facilities for towed recreational vehicles per axle. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Smith. Vote: 13 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions. Motion passes.

Motion by Commissioner White to ask the Department to adopt limitation of incompatible uses in the catch & release section of the Gunpowder River. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Coburn. Vote: 12 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstention. Motion passes.

Motion by Commissioner Sikorski to adopt the recommendations of the SFAC Recreational Angler Accountability Work Group. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Goldsborough. Vote: 10 in favor, 1 opposed, 2 abstentions. Motion passes.
