- Consider additional information that may be useful for providers, such as what to ask patients regarding exposures and consideration of other infections

Citizen flyer:

- Change "Vibrio infections are rare" to "Vibrio infections are rare in Maryland and nationwide" see b.1 in <u>Senate Bill 83</u>
- Change "This can be particularly dangerous for people with weakened immune systems" to "This can be particularly dangerous for people with liver disease or weakened immune systems"

Both flyers:

- In addition to providing a link to Maryland Healthy Beaches web site, include a link to MDE's web site (mde.maryland.gov) see b.6 in Senate Bill 83
- 2. Input pending from the Vibrio workgroup of the Sport Fisheries Advisory Commission
- 3. Contact the Mid-Atlantic office of the <u>American Liver Foundation</u> and other groups related to conditions that increase vulnerability or exposure risk to see if they could distribute the citizen flyer to members
