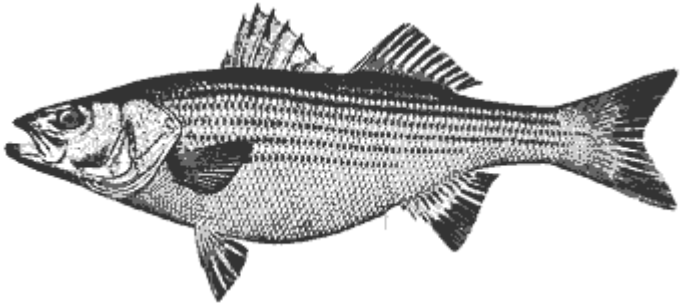

Captain's Meeting at Nauti-Goose: Friday, October 28, 2011 6:00 - 8:00 pm. Registration
numbers assigned, and any additional rules and regulations will be clarified during the meeting.

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEE: \$300.00 per boat. No restriction on the number of anglers per boat. Captain of the boat is the tournament applicant.

TOURNAMENT DATES, TIMES and LOCATION: Saturday, October 29, 2011. Starting time (lines in water) is 6:30 am and all boats must be at Anchor Marina docks by no later than 3:45 for fish weigh-in. The Tournament will take place in the Upper Chesapeake Bay with the following nautical parameters: North of the Bay Bridge, South of the 1-95 Bridge over the Susquehanna, North of the Kent Narrows Bridge and West of the Chesapeake City Bridge.

ELIGIBLE FISH & FISHING METHODS: This Tournament shall be held in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Maryland Department of Natural Resources. Striped bass **only 28 inches or more** - All fish must be caught by hook and line as described by MD DNR recreational standards. Wire line is allowed as line or leader; dummy lines are permitted; chumming and live-lining will be permitted.

WEATHER AND RISK OF LOSS: There is no Weather Committee. Anglers enter and participate in this tournament at their own risk. Anglers must make their own judgments whether to fish under the prevailing weather conditions based on the size and seaworthiness of their boat, their seamanship skills and any other relevant factors.

CANCELLATION: The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel the Tournament in the event not enough boats enter the tournament. In the event of a cancellation by the Tournament Committee, a full refund will be issued to all Captains.

REFUNDS: In the event a Captain is unable to participate, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

SELECTION OF FISH FOR WEIGH-IN: Each Boat is limited to weigh-in two (2) Rockfish. Striped bass must be at least 28 inches to qualify for weigh-in. Fish will be measured from tip of nose to squeezed tip of tail to qualify for weigh-in. It is prohibited to sort, cull, high grade, or replace any fish already in possession. Any fish taken into possession by holding in a live well or on a stringer or in any other fish holding devices shall be deemed as part of the daily bag limit. Once the daily bag limit is reached, fishing is NO LONGER permitted. The Anglers on each boat must choose which fish to be weighed. Anglers may not use an official Weigh-Station scale to determine which fish to weigh-in. Door prizes for heaviest Perch and Catfish.

WEIGH-IN: WEIGH-IN WILL BEGIN AT 2:00 pm and END AT 4:00 pm at ANCHOR MARINA ON OCTOBER 29, 2011. FISH MUST BE BROUGHT TO ANCHOR MARINA FOR OFFICIAL WEIGH-IN BY BOAT DIRECTLY FROM FISHING BY WATER. Fish must be brought to Anchor Marina's official Weigh-Station by water in the same boat that they were landed. Captains or their designee must be present during weigh-in and must have their copy of this registration form in hand. All fish weighed in will be issued an official weigh-in receipt bearing the catch weight. Captains must object to the catch weight before the weigh-in receipt is issued. Upon receipt of the weigh-in receipt, the catch weight shall be deemed accurate, final and agreed upon by the Captain. Captains may weigh-in at any time the weigh station is open. All fish are subject to examination, internally and externally, as the Weigh-Master deems necessary. All fish weighed in will be prominently marked by the Weigh-Master. Weigh-Masters may confiscate or report suspect fish to the Tournament Committee without protest. Weigh-Masters are authorized to require Proof of Tournament registration and photo identification at time of weigh-in. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to mark the weigh ticket of any suspect fish, or to require the Tournament Captain to sign a weigh ticket.

PROTEST: Protests shall be placed immediately upon knowledge of a Rules violation. Protests must be made via email to aviatfoundation@yahoo.com by midnight October 29, 2011.

FISH ONBOARD: No uncleaned tournament fish can be on the boat before the start of the day.

RULES and RULE CHANGES: Tournament rule changes may be made by the Tournament Committee at any time up to the first Captain's Meeting. It is the responsibility of all participants to familiarize themselves with all the rules and regulations of this Tournament and to abide by these rules and regulations. Any changes in Rules and Regulations will be announced at the Captain's Meeting on Friday, October 28th from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at Nauti Goose.

DISQUALIFICATION: The Tournament Committee reserves the sole and absolute discretion to disqualify any angler, crew, captain, registrant or vessel at any time. Persons may be disqualified from the tournament because of a rule violation, regardless of the severity of the violation. All participants agree to abide by tournament rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. Decisions as to the disqualification or eligibility of any vessel, crew, or fish weighed in shall be made solely by the Tournament Committee and its decisions shall be final and incontestable. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to disqualify any boat at any time for misrepresentation made on any application or registration form by any member of the boat, any suspicious activity or unsportsmanlike conduct. Any boat disqualified shall be for the entire tournament, and shall result in the forfeiture of all tournament fees and prize money even if the disqualification was made after the prize money was awarded.

RISKS and WAIVERS: Tournament participants accept the risks and dangers involved in such activity, and they acknowledge that unanticipated or unexpected dangers may occur. Participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless: Anchor Marina and/or Mount Aviat Academy and/or The Aviat Foundation, its officers, directors, members, committee members, its assigns, sponsors, lessees, agents, and employees from any and all liability for any: claim, loss, injury, damage, demands, actions, chooses in action, costs, accidents, libel, slander, negligence and/or death suffered by any member, family, crew boat and/or other persons which may occur during their participation in a Tournament. All anglers further release Anchor Marina and/or Mount Aviat Academy and/or The Aviat Foundation, its officers, directors, committee members and sponsors from any liability for libel, slander, loss, damage, negligence, injury and / or death suffered by any member, family, crew, boat and/or other person which may occur during the Tournament.

CAPTAIN NUMBER: Each Captain MUST have in their possession at all times a copy of this registration form which contains the registration number issued by the Tournament Committee. This captain number must be presented to the Weigh-Master before weighing fish.

POLYGRAPH: All fish eligible for cash prizes may be subject to the examination by a Tournament Committee member. In addition, each Captain and its anglers/occupants hereby agree and consent to voluntarily submit to a polygraph examination (s). In the event said Captain and/or its anglers/occupants refuses to submit to a polygraph and/or a response to deemed untruthful by the polygraph examiner, said Captain/Anglers and/or occupants shall be immediately disqualified and shall not be entitled to any entry fee refund and/or prize award.

SPORTSMANSHIP: The Tournament Committee may disqualify any Vessel, Captain, crew, participant, or angler who is involved in unsportsmanlike conduct; a knowing violation of the Rules, or for any reason that believes the acts warrant disqualification.

OPEN TOURNAMENT: The tournament is open to everyone - charter boat captains, professional fishermen and recreational anglers.
